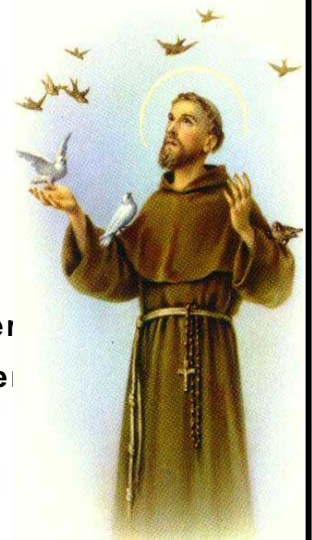

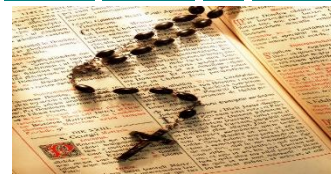

All are welcome to spend time with Jesus, present in the Blessed Sacrament.

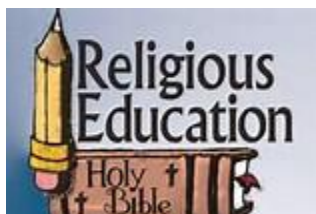
Confessions: 30 minutes prior to each mass. The Rosary is prayed before each mass.
