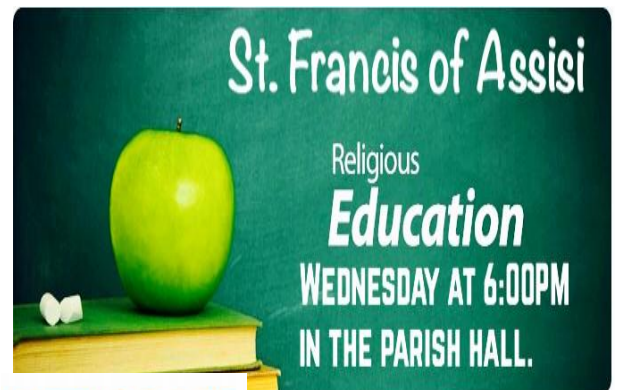
EIM Workshop:
