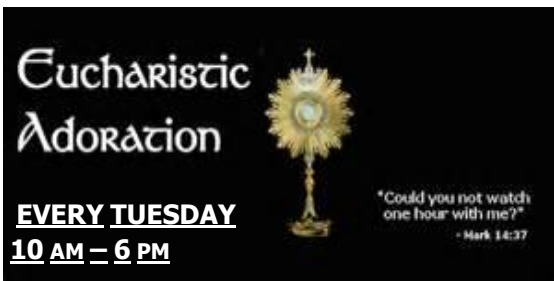

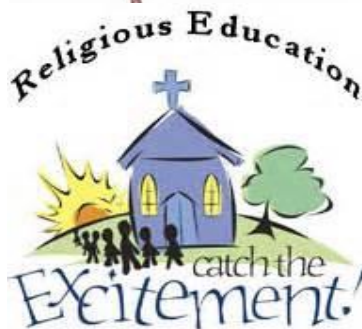
**RED-C Catholic Radio:**
