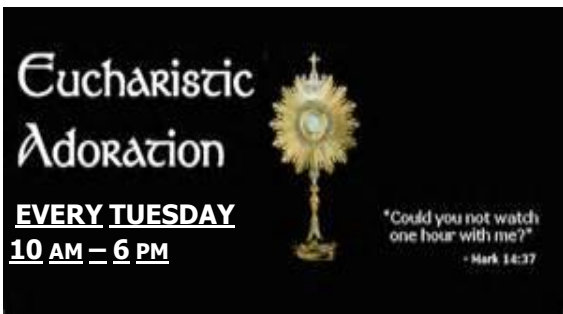

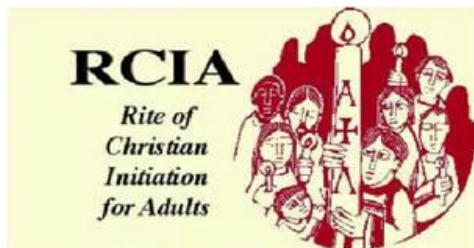
DCCW:
