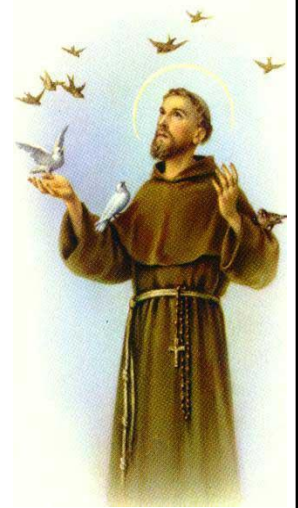

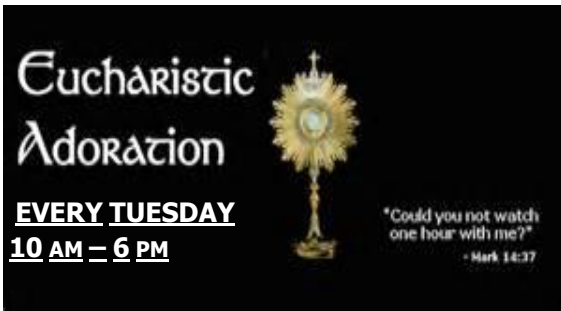

Ethics and Integrity in Ministry:

We highly value the many volunteers who, through their generous giving of time, talent, and treasure, enrich our parish, and serve our children and vulnerable adults. In complying with diocesan policy regarding the Ethics and Integrity in Ministry program and setting a higher standard for ourselves, all those in volunteer positions that involve work or service in ministries, programs or organizations, must become and remain EIM compliant. Ministry with minors and/or vulnerable adults pertains to any ministry, program, or organization that serves youth or vulnerable adults in any manner or which functions at a time and place where minors or vulnerable adults are typically present. A listing of such ministries/programs or organizations includes, but is not limited to: Communion ministry, choir, home bound, Altar Society, Religious Education, Bible study, Fundraiser events, BVS, and transportation ministries.

On August 1, 2016, the Diocese of Austin begun using a new education program for our EIM workshop which replaced the prior Basic/Refresher workshop format. The new program is a significant update of current training programs and we believe it is important for all persons that are required to be EIM compliant to participate in this program and receive this updated information. Consequently, all clergy, religious, seminarians and employees, and all volunteers serving in ministry to minors or the vulnerable, will attend this new program when they are next due for a workshop. Additionally, anyone new to the Diocese of Austin wishing to serve in ministry here must attend this new EIM workshop in order to be compliant with diocesan EIM policies. Verification of safe environment training from a previous diocese no longer serves as training in the Diocese of Austin. All those who volunteer at St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Church must attend a workshop ASAP! You are either non-complaint at this time or your compliance is ending in the next couple of months.

An EIM workshop is scheduled at St. Anthony Church in Bryan on May 10 from 6:30PM – 8:30PM

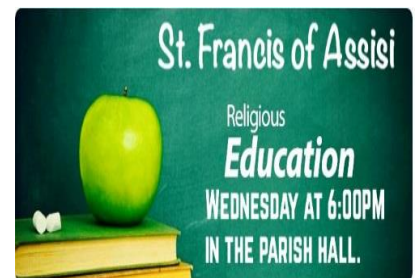
